

## Trophies & Prizes

Unless the number of entries merits splitting the tournament, it will be run as a single section, but titles will be awarded for the top U13, top U15 and top U18, with associated engraved trophies to keep for one year and individual trophies to keep permanently.

In addition, money prizes will be awarded as follows:  
U18 – £100; U15 - £50; U13 - £25

If a player from a younger age group should be placed ahead of the leader from an older age group, the trophies will be distributed as above, but the prize money will be topped up to the higher amount. In the event of any ties, titles and prize money will be shared.

In addition to the individual trophies and prizes, an inscribed chess clock will be awarded to a top-scoring Oxon school (full details available on request).

## Qualification for Entry

Players should be under 18 years of age as of 1st September 2018 and affiliated to Oxfordshire by birth, residence, school and/or chess club attendance. Please indicate basis of affiliation on the entry form.

ECF membership is required to enter this tournament. For information on ECF membership see <http://www.englishchess.org.uk/membership/joining/guide-to-joining-the-ecf/>. Please provide your ECF membership number on the tournament entry form. Those wishing to join the ECF for the first time can arrange one year's free Junior Silver membership prior to the tournament (via a link to an electronic form at <http://englishchess.org.uk/Juniors/>).

The tournament will run alongside, but separately to, the Under 9 and Under 11 county trials.

## Byes

Competitors may request a half point bye in one of the first five rounds by indicating this on the entry form. Half point byes are not permitted in more than one round nor in the final round of the tournament.

## Late registrations

Please try to enter and pay by 2 January 2018 to avoid any late entry fees. We will not treat an entry as being received until the entry fee has been paid. If you enter on-line or by email you must send the entry fee by bank transfer or by post if you wish to avoid late entry surcharges. Late entries will not be accepted after 9.15am on the day of the tournament.

Prize giving will take place in the hall immediately following the last round on Sunday (but not before 5.30 pm in the case of an early finish).

### Time Limits

The time control will be 60 minutes each plus 15 seconds increment from move 1.

Refreshments will be available for purchase on site, provided by Hacketts Coffee Bar and Bistro. There will also be a small junior chess bookstall.

### Tournament System & Rules

The tournament will be run using a Swiss pairing system; it is not a knock-out competition. Mobile phones and electronic devices capable of sending or receiving signals must be switched off and left untouched during the playing times.

Results will be submitted for ECF Standard Play grading. All players must score their games on the tournament-provided score sheets.
