

Privacy Policy

Oxfordshire Chess Association is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy explains when, how, and why we collect personal data about people.

Who we are

Oxfordshire Chess Association (OCA) administers competitions for chess clubs in Oxfordshire.

How we collect your information

The only information we obtain about people is provided either by the people themselves or by their team officials. We do not collect personal data simply as a result of a person visiting our website.

How your information is used

Results of the competitions administered by OCA are recorded on an Oxfordshire Chess section of a website. The website also provides results of competitions that are not organised by OCA, alongside contact details for participating clubs and for OCA officials.

The personal data we obtain is applied for the following purposes:

- To identify members of the English Chess Federation (ECF).
- To submit results of matches played in competitions organised by OCA to the ECF for grading purposes.
- To register players to play for Oxfordshire in competitions in which OCA enters teams.
- To submit results of matches played by Oxfordshire teams to other organisations running competitions in which OCA participates.
- To facilitate communications between clubs playing in competitions organised by OCA.
- To provide contact points for Oxfordshire clubs.

Consistently with this, the contact details provided to us by users of the website may be used to contact them by mail, telephone, fax or e-mail for the purposes of the OCA.

We will hold the personal data that are required for grading purposes for as long as a person participates in either an OCA team or a competition organised by OCA, and for a reasonable time afterwards.

Contact details for club officials (including team captains) are under the control of those users and can be amended or deleted by the user in question at any time.

These data are held pursuant to the legitimate interests of Oxfordshire Chess Association which is the basis on which your data as set out is processed.

Who can access information

Unless required by law, we do not sell, rent or otherwise share personal data with other third parties.

Rights

Users of the website can ask for a copy of the data we hold about them. If a user provides information about another person, it is their responsibility to ensure that the other person has given their explicit consent to the processing of their personal data.

Should you have any unresolved complaints about the way we process your personal data, you have the right to make a formal complaint to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
